Text: Luke 15:11–24

Topic(s): Grace, Repentance, Sin, Prodigal Son

Big Idea of the Message: The prodigal son reminds us that God's grace is inexhaustible: we can never out-sin his forgiveness.

Application Point: When we feel buried in shame because of sin, we can still turn toward God, knowing that he will not reject us.
