Topic: God, Worship, the Father

Big Idea of the Message: The central focus of this story is a proper view of God the Father, not just the actions we perform in response to him.

Application Point: A correct understanding of God's inexhaustible love will help us not fall into one of the two extremes of law or licentiousness.

Discussion Questions:

2. If you're completely honest, do you think God still loves and wants us when we're sinning at our worst?
3. How do you think loving God better in all areas of your life can help you from going into sin?
4. In which ways do you think understanding the love of God is different than many people's view of an overly religious Christianity?

6. What does it make you feel like to know that God rejoices over you?
