



#### **Week 4 – Table Manners**

**Text:** Luke 14:12–14

**Topics:** Hospitality, Service, Love

**Big Idea of the Message:** Hospitality should be geared toward strangers and unbelievers.

**Application Point:** Many people met Jesus at a dinner table. Are they meeting him at your dinner table?

#### **Discussion Questions:**

6. How are we going to keep each other accountable in this?
7. Do we have the love for our neighbors to stay in relationship with them even if they don't come to faith in our lifetime? Do we love them for themselves, not for the conversion story we can get out of them?
