



### **Week 1 – Worship Together**

**Text:** Acts 2:42-47

**Topics:** Worship, Gathering

**Big Idea of the Message:** Worship is a foundational to being a follower of Jesus. It's not just something we do, but who we are - people who regularly give worth to God. And scripture shows us, that we aren't meant to do that alone but in the community of believers. We do this because Jesus redeems our whole lives, setting us free to praise Him in the morning and evening, in laughter and tears, with a joy that declares He is sufficient in every circumstance.

**Application Point:** Saved people worship together.

2. **Read Psalm 122:1, 4.** The Bible treats regular corporate worship not as an option but as an ought. Since our worship does not make up for anything lacking in God, why do you think God commanded His children to gather regularly to worship together?
3. **Read Acts 2:42-47.** What stands out to you about this passage? Why?
4. What do you think would cause a visitor to sense the presence of God when a church is assembled?
5. Share a time that you were encouraged by worshipping together.
6. How can we keep each other accountable in this area?
7. How can we pray for you?
