Text: Ephesians 4:1-6, 11-16

Topics: Spiritual Growth, Community, Spiritual Disciplines

Big Idea of the Message: Growth is essential to life. If you're not growing, you're dying. As a church, we want to grow intentionally. Our greatest desire is to make disciples who make disciples. It's a communal effort. Through bible classes, discipleship groups, and growth groups we sharpen one another and help each other grow. Each of us needs others to help us grow.
