Week 5 – Love

Text: Romans 8:31-39

Topics: God's love, victory

Big Idea of the Message: As we trust in God's unfailing love as the strength of our lives, we will experience his promise of our being more than conquerors.

Application Point: The love of God is greater than any person, circumstance, sin, or failure.

Discussion Questions:

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. "These things" in verse 31 refers to all of Romans chapter 8, but specifically to verses 28-30. Why do those verses prompt Paul to say that if God for us, no one can be against us?
3. Read verse 32. It can be a confusing sentence, so take time to break it down. What does verse 32 say? Why is it important to the whole flow of Romans 8 and to verses 31-39?
4. What does this passage say about God's heart toward us?
5. How would you respond to someone who says they aren't sure God really loves them?
6. What does it mean to you to be "more than a conqueror"?
7. What areas in your life do you need strength to trust in God's love or in your being victorious through him?
8. How can we pray for you?
