## Come, Follow Me – January 26, 2025

**1.** *What does it mean to truly follow Jesus?* In Luke 5:1-11, we see Jesus calling ordinary fishermen into an extraordinary mission. How does this passage challenge the way we view following Jesus? How is it different from just agreeing with facts about Jesus?

**2.** *The role of questions and doubts in our faith journey*. Peter had doubts about Jesus' instructions but still chose to act in **Luke 5:5-7**. How can we bring our doubts to Jesus without staying stuck in them? What role do questions and doubts play in your own journey of faith?

**3.** *Moving from deconstruction to reconstruction*. **Hebrews 5:12** challenges believers to move beyond basic teachings. Why is it essential for our faith to grow beyond a state of constant questioning? How can we move from deconstruction to reconstruction in our faith, and what does spiritual growth look like?

**4.** *Active participation in God's mission*. **James 1:22** reminds us that faith requires action. Jesus called Peter to act even when he was skeptical. What does it mean to move from being an observer to an active participant in God's work, and how can we live that out in our own lives?

**5.** *Humility before God*. In **Luke 5:8-10**, Peter's response to the miracle was one of humility. How does recognizing our limitations lead to greater dependence on God? What does humility before God look like in your life?

**6.** *The role of community in following Jesus*. In **Ecclesiastes 4:9-12**, we see the importance of supporting one another. When Peter's nets were full, he called others to help. How has community helped you in your faith journey, and how can you invite others into this journey?

**7.** *Is the way I'm doing life getting in the way of following Jesus?* The disciples left their old way of life to follow Jesus. How might our own habits, priorities, and distractions be keeping us from fully saying "yes" to His call? What are some areas where we might need to let go of our old ways to more fully embrace the call to follow Him?
