Through your leadership, you will nurture our teens and empower them to build strong Christian connections, equipping them to live out their faith in meaningful and impactful ways.

Primary Responsibilities

- Youth Ministry Vision: Implement and refine a vision for Youth Ministry, emphasizing the role of parents, families, and the church community in supporting faith formation. Collaborate with the Elders, other Ministers, and the Ministry Coordination Team to establish objectives that align with this vision, fostering spiritual growth and discipleship in all students and providing a supportive environment for each individual to develop their relationship with Christ.
- Spiritual Leadership: Model personal spiritual growth through consistent Bible study, prayer, fasting, and continuing learning around adolescent and family development. Lead by example, modeling a life transformed by Christ's love, humility, and servant leadership, inspiring others to follow His example.
- **Student Discipleship:** Create and implement a comprehensive discipleship plan to guide students in their spiritual growth. Help our students become life-long and deep learners of scripture with a Christ-formed servant leader disposition. Develop curriculum, providing mentoring, and offering hands-on opportunities to apply their faith.
- Teaching and Worship: Lead age-appropriate classes, Bible studies, and events that nurture spiritual growth, and foster connection with other Christians. - Community and Service: Organize and lead opportunities for teens to serve others in our local Fairfax community and beyond. Guide students in engaging with those in need, encouraging them to step outside their comfort zones to reflect God's love and contribute to the growth of His kingdom.
- Equipping Parents and Volunteers: Encourage and empower parents to engage actively in their child's spiritual development. Provide support and resources to help parents nurture their children's faith, foster spiritual conversations, and build strong, Christ-centered families. Actively seek out and engage mentor volunteers who are passionate about supporting the Youth Ministry. Foster ways for mentor volunteers to connect with teens in the Youth program and participate in youth activities.
- Mentorship and Counseling: Provide age-appropriate pastoral care, counseling, and mentorship
 to students and families, offering support for emotional and spiritual needs. Guide teens through
 personal challenges and life changes, connecting their individual journeys back to Christ and their
